### WHO WERE THE SAMARITANS?

We read in the Gospel: Jesus was not welcomed into a certain Samaritan village. The reason given for this rejection is: ‘He was making for Jerusalem.’ The Samaritans had a great animosity for the Jews in general and for Jerusalem as their capital. Jesus was a Jew and He was heading to Jerusalem. In the eyes of the Samaritans these were reasons enough to refuse Him entry.

What was the origin of this hostility between Jews and Samaritans? As with many deeply held resentments, the parties concerned were once united. They had a common origin as descendants of Jacob who had 12 sons. These 12 sons were the fathers of the 12 tribes of Israel. The ancestors of both Jews and Samaritans were the Hebrew slaves in Egypt. They were one nation, Israel, when they took possession of the Promised Land. They were one Kingdom when David and then his son Solomon ruled over them. But after King Solomon died (around 930BC) the northern part of the Kingdom split away from the south. The northern part became known as Samaria (from where we get the name Samaritans) and the southern part was known as Judah (Jews) with Jerusalem as its capital. In 721BC Samaria was conquered by the Assyrians and the people inter-married and compromised with pagan religions. Jerusalem held firm until 586BC when it too was conquered, this time by the Babylonians. The Jews did not compromise or mix with the pagans.

By the time Jesus was preaching the Good News these 2 factions had already been in bitter conflict for many centuries. After Jesus’ death and resurrection the Samaritans were among the first to receive the Gospel and accept Jesus as the Christ.
