## ST JAMES THE APOSTLE

On Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July we celebrate the Feast of St James. He is often called 'St. James the Greater' because another of the 12 apostles was also called James. The other James came to be known as 'St James the Less'. St James the Greater was born in Bethsaida on the shores of Lake Galilee, the son of Zebedee and Salome and brother of John. John, James' younger brother, also became an Apostle, and wrote a Gospel, some letters and the Book of Revelation (Apocalypse), which we find in the New Testament. James and John worked with their father as fishermen on the lake. When Jesus came to the shores of the Sea of Galilee, He saw the two brothers and called them. They both responded readily and generously to the call and are counted, along with Peter and Andrew, among the first disciples of Jesus. James was one of the select three, with Peter and John, who witnessed the Transfiguration of Jesus on the top of the mountain when Jesus appeared in glory. These three were also those who accompanied Jesus in prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane.

Following the sending of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, the apostles set out to preach the Gospel across the Roman empire. It is thought that James brought the Good News to Spain. On his return to Jerusalem, King Herod had James executed by beheading. He is known as the first apostle to be martyred. His body was taken to Spain by some of his followers who buried him there. In the ninth century his remains were rediscovered and moved to a tomb in Compostela and a church was built. His relics are now in the great Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela.
