## DIVES AND LAZARUS

It is a characteristic of Luke that he has a great sensitivity for the poor and includes in his Gospel many aspects of Jesus’ ministry with the impoverished and weak not found elsewhere. The name of the poor, sick man lying, dying in the street is familiar to us: Lazarus. This is the same name as that of the man mentioned in John’s Gospel as the brother of Martha and Mary. These two sisters, when they send a frantic message to Jesus telling Him that Lazarus is very ill, say: “he whom you love is sick.” Lazarus, the brother of Martha and Mary, is a real person. Lazarus in the parable is simply a character in the tale. But perhaps Jesus chose this particular name for the story because it was close to His heart. Whatever the reason, the poor man in the parable has a name.

What is the name of the rich man? As with the title of this newsletter-piece, many people call this parable: Dives and Lazarus. This may give the impression that the rich man’s name is *Dives*. *Dives* is simply a Latin word meaning *rich*. Here it means rich man. In the story this rich man, who feasts magnificently every day, has no name. Or rather, his name is not divulged. This is not an accidental slip on the part of Jesus, nor of Luke who reports the parable. It is intentional. A deliberate contrast is made between the one whose name we know and the one who is anonymous to us.

Generally, in our culture and society it is the rich and successful whose names are known to us. The poor are nameless. But not for God. He knows us all by name; He especially cherishes the poor ones.
