## FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF ST PETER'S CATHEDRAL, LANCASTER

On Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> October we will celebrate, along with all other parishes in the Diocese of Lancaster, the Dedication of our Cathedral. It was consecrated and dedicated to St Peter in 1859. This actually occurred on 4<sup>th</sup> October, but since this date clashes with the feast of St. Francis, our annual celebration of the dedication is moved to the 5<sup>th</sup>.

St Peter's became a Cathedral when the Diocese of Lancaster was formed in 1924. It may seem a little strange for us in Carlisle to mark as a feast the dedication of a church almost 70 miles away. But it makes perfect sense when we appreciate that the Cathedral is the mother church of the diocese and a symbol of unity. The word "cathedral" derives from the Greek word "kathedra," meaning "chair." The chair of the diocesan bishop is the seat from which he guides the life of the Church in a particular geographical region known as a diocese. This chair is a symbol of his authority. The church in which this chair is housed is consequently known as the cathedral church — the bishop's own parish church.

The deep message of this celebration is one of unity and life. By marking this feast, we are not commemorating the foundation of a building. We are rather acknowledging that we form one Body in Christ. When Christ established His Church, He gave it a structure of leadership and service in imitation of Himself, the Good Shepherd. The Pope and Bishops of the Church are successors to the apostles. They have the Christ-given task of teaching the faithful the message of the Gospel, of being ministers of the Sacraments that we may grow in holiness and governing the Church to maintain unity.
