## BISHOP'S VISITATION TO THE PARISH

Bishop Paul will visit the parish this weekend 24<sup>th</sup> /25<sup>th</sup> June and next weekend 1<sup>st</sup> /2<sup>nd</sup> July. He will only be able to be present at 6 of our 8 weekend Masses, therefore 2 of our Sunday congregations will not meet him. You do have the option to attend any Mass you wish, this way, you can be present at any of the Masses celebrated by the bishop.

After each Mass the bishop will speak to parishioners over refreshments.

Through such a visit the Bishop will be able to form a perspective of the life of faith of the parish. He will get a sense of the community, the faith education at all ages, the sacramental and liturgical life of the parish. Also, by meeting the people and the Parish Pastoral Council members he can assess the cooperation and collaboration in service and leadership of our structures. He can evaluate the level of service to society and the relationship of the parish with the diocesan and universal Church. He will examine the financial organization and the state of recordkeeping of sacramental registers and other archival material.

Perhaps the most important aspect of the visit will be the opportunity for our Bishop to bring encouragement and hope to us all. He will celebrate Mass, proclaim the Word of God and preach to the parish community.
