READERS AND EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION

READERS

When Sacred Scripture is proclaimed in the Church, God himself speaks to his people, and Christ, present in his word, proclaims the Gospel. Therefore, the readings from the Word of God are an element of high importance in the Liturgy. According to the ancient tradition and the teaching of the Church, the readings other than the Gospel are proclaimed by lay ministers called readers (*lectors*). This is an essential service to the Church.

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION

Holy Communion unites us to Christ so that we become one body with Him and, through Him, with the whole Church. It is a very ancient custom that those who could not gather with the other members of the Church on a Sunday due to sickness would have Holy Communion brought to them in their homes. It has also become the custom that the priest may be assisted at Mass with the distribution of holy Communion. This is an important service to the Church.

Since being a **Reader** or an **Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion** are such important roles in the Liturgy of the Church, we should give time for appropriate reflection and training in these roles.

Training for Readers: Saturday 29th July 10am - 12noon (offered as a back-up on Thursday 3rd August 7pm-9pm. You need only come to one.)

Training for Extraordinary Ministers: Saturday 12th August 10am - 12noon (offered as a back-up on Thursday 17th August 7pm-9pm. You need only come to one.)
