## THE EASTER TRIDUUM - 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> MARCH

Sundown on Holy Thursday to sundown on Easter Sunday is the three-day period known as the Easter Triduum. It is one, great, single festival recounting the last days of Jesus' life.

On Holy Thursday at the evening *Mass of the Lord's Supper* (OLSJ 7pm) we re-live the institution of the Eucharist and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, and the institution of the priesthood, which took place the evening before Jesus was crucified. During this Mass there is the "washing of the feet" ceremony, where the priest, imitating Jesus, washes the feet of others to signify his role as servant. Mass concludes with a procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the "altar of repose," a place where the consecrated Host is kept, away from the main altar where Mass is normally celebrated.

Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence. This is the day of the crucifixion. The altar is plain and bare. There is no consecrated Host in the tabernacle; it was carried away on Holy Thursday night to the "altar of repose" to signify Jesus' death. The tabernacle doors are left open to show that it is empty. Jesus is gone. Good Friday is the only day of the year on which no Masses are offered. Instead, we listen to the story of the crucifixion and venerate the cross. (There is a service in each church this day; 1pm at OLSW, CtK, St A. 3pm at OLSJ, St B, St MM)

After nightfall on Holy Saturday we celebrate the Easter Vigil (OLSJ 8pm), rejoicing in the resurrection of Jesus. It is the most glorious, beautiful, and important celebration for the Church.

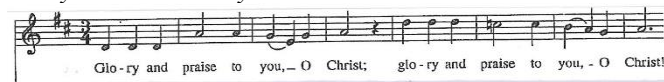
