MASS FOR THE SICK AND THE SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

In our parish there are many who suffer sickness and ill health. There are also many who visit the housebound with Holy Communion. The St Vincent de Paul Society (SVP) is active in visiting and supporting those who are sick and alone. Through the initiative and inspiration of the SVP we will be offering and hosting a Mass for the sick of the parish, followed by lunch and a time to be together. During the Mass the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered to those in need.

This Sacrament helps unite those who are suffering with Jesus' saving and healing power; we receive forgiveness for sins and comfort in our distress, and restoration in spirit. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the priest anoints the seriously ill, injured, or the elderly with the oil of the sick. The oil of the sick is one of the oils blessed by the bishop at the Chrism Mass during Holy Week. Suffering is a part of life, but Jesus unites our hardship with his passion and death, so that through our discomfort we can participate in his saving and healing work. In this Sacrament we are assured that Jesus walks with us in our frailty and affliction.

The Mass for the sick with the Sacrament of Anointing will take place on **Saturday 1st June at 12noon at OLSJ**, followed by lunch in the New Waterton Hall. All the sick of the parish are especially warmly invited. Details as to how to book for the refreshments will follow in future newsletters.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDING NOTICE

It is mandatory for all volunteers in the church, whatever the role, to engage with Safeguarding Training. Volunteers requiring DBS checks undertake either Level 2 or 3 on-line. This is in place in our parish and DBS certificates are already issued. However, the majority of volunteers are classed at Level 1, welcomers, readers, musicians, choir, Eucharistic Ministers, who minister in church only, cleaners; flower arrangers, tea/coffee makers, volunteers at BCRH etc, and this is done via a leaflet. Your Safeguarding Representative (contact details on every church notice board) who will be at the back of church after Mass will give you a leaflet and ask that you sign receipt of the leaflet. This is the Level 1 requirement for all Catholic churches in the country. I ask you to be proactive in cooperation with this new instruction and come forward to receive the leaflet.
