THE DEDICATION OF THE CATHEDRAL IN LANCASTER

On Saturday 5th October we celebrate the Feast of the dedication of the Cathedral in Lancaster. When Lancaster and the south of our Diocese was all part of Liverpool Diocese, St Peter's church was originally built as a parish church. When our own Diocese of Lancaster was founded in 2024 the church became St Peter's Cathedral. A *cathedral* is the place which houses the *kathedra* – the Chair – of the Bishop. This chair is a symbol of his authority to teach, sanctify and govern the people of Christ. The church in which this chair is housed is consequently known as a cathedral church. As we approach the centenary year for the Diocese it is good to reflect on the symbolic meaning of our Cathedral.

Christianity is not an idea or a philosophy or a system of personal beliefs, but a tangible, sacramental relationship with the person of Jesus Christ. God become man for our salvation, and He seeks to reach out and touch us, to heal and strengthen us, and to share with us that life which will endure beyond human death. So too, we reach out and touch Him, seeking the help we need to become whole. We come into 'touching distance' of Jesus through the life of the Church: Her prayer and spirituality, Her teaching, Her sacraments and the shared life of faith we experience with others of the same belief, near and far. This shared faith we call: Communion. In celebrating this feast we are affirming our communion in the one Catholic Faith with Paul Swarbrick our bishop, with Pope Francis and with all Catholics since the first disciples of Jesus to this present day in all parts of the world.

Our Lady of Lourdes and St Cuthbert – patrons of our Diocese – pray for us!
