POPE FRANCIS CONSECRATES RUSSIA AND UKRAINE TO MARY

On 25th March Pope Francis invited every Catholic Bishop around the world to join him in a “solemn Act of Consecration of humanity, and Russia and Ukraine in particular, to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.” The Pope lamented the immense suffering the war in Ukraine is inflicting upon its people and which is “threatening world peace.” He said, “At this dark hour, the Church is urgently called to intercede before the Prince of Peace and to demonstrate her closeness to those directly affected by the conflict.” The Pope expressed his gratitude to the many Catholics who have responded “with great generosity to my appeals for prayer, fasting, and charity.”

The Act of Consecration took place about 6:30pm Rome time, as the Pope led the prayer in St. Peter's Basilica. Pope Francis went on to lay out the meaning behind the consecration of Russia and Ukraine.

“This Act of Consecration is meant to be a gesture of the universal Church, which in this dramatic moment lifts up to God, through His Mother and ours, the cry of pain of all those who suffer and implore an end to the violence, and to entrust the future of our human family to the Queen of Peace.”

The Pope had invited all Bishops, priests, religious, and Catholic faithful to “assemble in their places of prayer on 25 March, so that God's Holy People may raise a heartfelt and choral plea to Mary our Mother.” Bishop Paul Swarbrick and many Catholics throughout our diocese joined the Pope in prayer. *Queen of Peace: Pray for us!*
